Adopt-A-Garden Program

Program intent: The purpose of this program is to encourage groups such as civic organizations and businesses to take an active role in helping to beautify the grounds of the Mount Holly Library.

Program Basics: Participants agree to maintain their garden for a minimum of one year. Participants provide labor involved with the planting and maintenance of their garden. In return the Mount Holly Library will post a sign indicating the name of the adopting agency. At the end of the year, participants will receive a special certificate of appreciation and will have the option of renewing their agreement.

Program Conditions:

1. The Mount Holly Library will periodically inspect the work accomplished by the adopting group.
2. The Mount Holly Library shall not be liable for any damage to the landscaped areas due to the installation or maintenance of any public facilities.
3. Participants will adopt for a minimum of one year.
4. Group members less than 15 year of age must be supervised by an adult. Large groups should be divided into teams of eight or fewer members.
5. Each time work is done at the site, the adopting group is requested to file an Activity Report detailing the number of people involved, hours spent and work accomplished.
6. The adopting group will receive copies of these program conditions. The signed agreement, safety tips, and an activity report.
7. When participating with children, work only during daylight hours and good weather.
